PAJA&BUREAU

Paja&Bureau is a furniture design and manufacturing company based in Ullanlinna, Helsinki, specializing in metal materials. The company produces its own brand collection of quality furniture pieces and other objects in addition to unique bespoke works and tailored interior space realizations. Products are designed and made by the company in-house in Ullanlinna and near Helsinki.

At the heart of each project is a deep respect for honest materials. We base our designs on the innate qualities of each individual material and emphasise those features by displaying structures and exposing natural surfaces rather than covering. This is reflected especially in our use of different metals and their various surface treatments which we've experimented with to highlight the nature of the material.



SHARED CURIOSITY

Paja&Bureau is the passion project and dream company of two left handed designer-makers from Helsinki. Eetu and Nino share vast experience and dedication working with different kinds of metals inspired by the inherent and expressive quality of the materials.

Designers by trade and craftsmen at heart Eetu and Nino have been collaborating since their paths met during artisan studies and a shared vision, curiosity and ambition gradually paved the way towards providing exquisite handmade furniture pieces for discerning people.

We started the company with the crystal clear mission to produce carefully designed and handmade high-end furniture, products that express our core philosophy and values as well as craftsmanship skills. In-depth knowledge of materials combined with intentional and patient design processes creates unique and functional art pieces that we can proudly present. Based on our experience from custom projects we have gained a detailed understanding of products in high demand. Our desire is to bring handmade artisan objects made of steel that last a lifetime to the Finnish design scene. 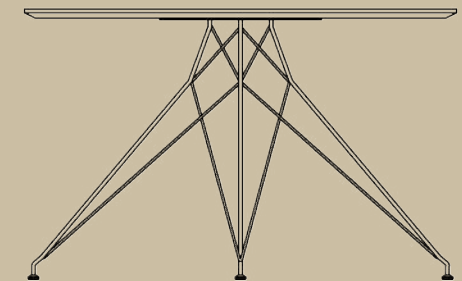


ETOILE

The frame of the Etoile dining table is based on a triangular structure that creates a very light yet durable support. Hand-bent and cold drawn steel bar welded frame is the base for a round oak top. The light material used in the legs gives a smooth figure for the table and keeps the surrounding space airy. Etoile's solid oak top is made in a carpentry studio in Helsinki. It is measured to fit a table seating for six people and to function both in daily life and during parties. Oak table tops age beautifully and last multiple generations. Etoile tables are built by hand in our workshop in Helsinki. The table frames come either in black powder coating or in bright, ageless chrome. The

dining table is finished by hand-turned and adjustable brass or steel feet.

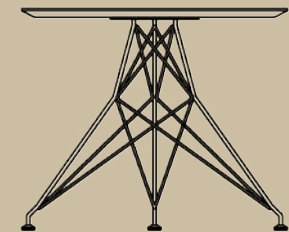


PETIT ETOILE

Petit Etoile coffee table is a tripod furniture whose triangular structure creates a spectacular architectural impression. It combines the classical but minimalistic style of industrial design from the last mid-century. The extremely light and durable frame is the base for a round top that is available as a gorgeous steel plate or as a timeless solid oak top. Tables are built by hand in our workshop in Helsinki. The table frames come either in black powder coating or in bright, ageless chrome. The table is finished by hand-turned and adjustable brass or steel feet. The steel top for the Petit Etoile coffee tables are made in small series where the patterns are

oxidized on each plate by using Paja&Bureau's own acid-treating method. An individual steel top is a work of art itself and it makes the coffee table an unforgettable eye catcher. Oak table tops are made in a carpentry studio, Helsinki.

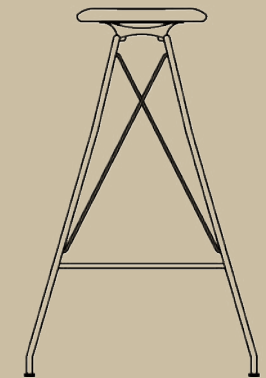


FOUETTE

Classic design elements together with modern technology and traditional craftsmanship creates the foundation for the Fouette series. Fouette is lively, light and offers a pleasant moment at a bar counter in a romantic corner café or a brief pause in the middle of hectic office life. Intimate streets of Paris and a spontaneous dance that makes your thoughts fly, have been the core inspiration for designing the Fouette series. There are two heights available for the Fouette bar stool: 75cm and 65cm. The material is cold drawn steel bar and the frame is hand-bent and welded in our workshop in Helsinki. The stool seat is made from a solid oak board by

lathe turning. Each seat is a unique work of art with branch sections and the individual beautiful grain patterns of the wood. The Fouette bar stool comes either in black powder coating or in bright, ageless chrome. The oak seat is waxed in order to tolerate time and wear for years. The feet options for the stool are steel, copper or brass.

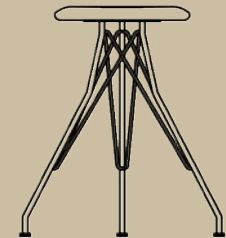


PETIT FOUETTE

The smallest stool of the Fouette series is a beautiful and practical piece of furniture which is meant to delight at home or at the office. The beautifully proportioned stool is suitable for different situations and pleasant to experience as part of the interior. Petit Fouette is 42 cm high. Material used in the stool is cold drawn steel bar. The frame is hand-bent and welded in our workshop in Helsinki. The stool seat is made from a solid oak board by lathe turning. The Petit Fouette stool is available either in black powder coating or in bright, ageless chrome. The oak

seat is waxed in order to tolerate time and wear for years. The feet options for the stool are steel, copper or brass.

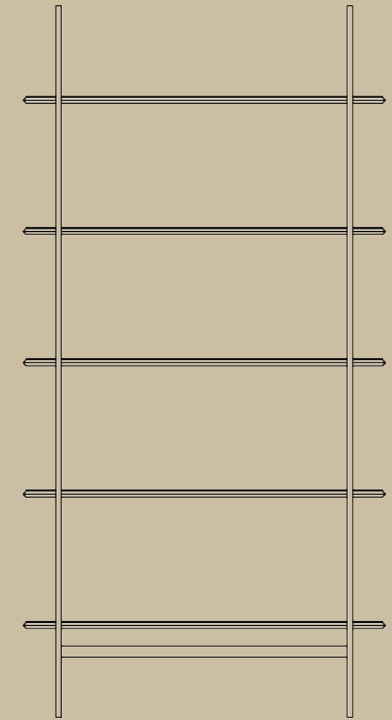


RISOLUTO

MEASUREMENTS

Calm majesticism and robust elegance fuse together in the archtomic Risoluto bookshelf to create an impressive and meditative sculptural piece of furniture. Inspired by dark and mysterious monoliths, brutalist architecture and eastern philosophies Risoluto is an object meant to be observed and contemplated. The structure consists of hot rolled solid steel rods that gives the furniture a unique haptic surface and sculptural feel. The shelf structure seams have been soldered with brass instead of welding to emphasize the ethereal quality of the bookshelf. The diagonal square

rods that make up the horizontal shelf supports provide a slanted frame for the solid oak shelf boards which have a corresponding edge which connects with the steel structure perfectly. There's also the option of having some of the shelf boards shorter in order to store higher objects on the shelf. The whole surface of the steel structure is treated only with a light oxidation and a wax coat to protect the natural feel of the material. The Risoluto bookshelf can also be custom ordered to fit to a specific space.

BECOME THE FURNITURE OWNER

As the owner of the furniture, you'll become part of its life cycle. The patina that accumulates in the furniture over time reflects your shared moments of everyday life. The piece will last forever in regular use and when treated properly. We on the other hand are pleased to answer any questions connected to the furniture collection and offer a lifetime warranty for the furniture.

Each product is serial numbered and accompanied by a certificate of authenticity.

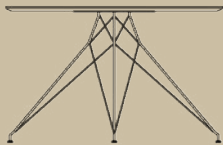
RETURN POLICY

WARRANTY

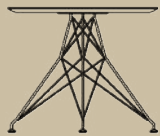

BLACK TRUMPET PASTA

- 200g fresh black trumpet mushrooms
- 2-3 shallot onions
- A teaspoon of fresh red chopped chili
- 2 dl heavy cream
- 2 tablespoon of butter
- fistful of fresh chopped thyme
- Salt and pepper from the mill
- Olive oil
- White vinegar
- Grated lemon peel
- Parmesan
- 350g spaghetti

Bring a large pan of salted water to boil.

Chop and add mushrooms to a hot frying pan, cook until most of the water comes out. Add some butter, take the pan aside to wait.

Add chopped onions with olive oil to the pan, sauté around 2 minutes without letting them brown too much. Add a splash of vinegar, butter and lemon peel. Let simmer on low heat under the lid.

Cook the spaghetti in salted water until it becomes al dente.

While the spaghetti is cooking, add cream and mushrooms to the pan. Stir and add thyme, salt and pepper. Leave a fistful of mushrooms and thyme for the top of the dish.

When the pasta is ready, add it to the pan with a splash of the cooking water. Add grated parmesan and toss gently in the pan.

Garnish with the mushrooms left aside and thyme. Serve immediately on Etoile dining table.
